

LEGACY BACKPACK BUDDIES PROJECT

During one week in July busloads of Central Phoenix and West Valley students from low-income families will be transported from their schools to a very special place. Each child will leave with a backpack filled with brand new back-to-school clothing and personal items worth more than \$300. For many of the children, these garments will be the first new clothes and shoes they have ever owned.

Each student receives:

Backpack	3 undergarments
2 Polo shirts	“Stitches of Love” garment sewn by a volunteer
Shorts	Back-to-school supplies
Sweatshirt	Personal hygiene and health items
Pair of new shoes	Health education information
Belt	
3 pairs of socks	

BACK-TO-SCHOOL

Each year, Legacy Connection asks corporations, organizations and individual donors to participate in the Legacy Backpack Buddies Project by sponsoring Central Phoenix and West Valley Title I elementary schools, classes and students so that they may attend the Back-to-School Clothing Drive Association (BTSCDA) event. Altogether, over 4,000 students from more than 100 schools participate.

Some of the Legacy Connection sponsored school districts include: Alhambra, Cartwright, Murphy, Osborn, Phoenix, Deer Valley, Peoria and Glendale. Students who participate in the event are from families living at or below the federal poverty level.

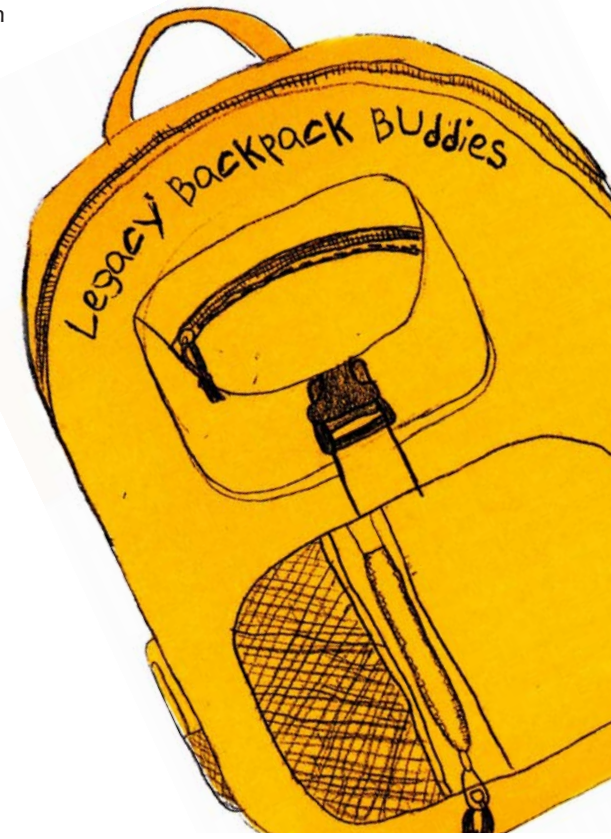
